The award is bestowed upon a private or public sector group or individual and the designers involved with an existing project which are exemplary in creating an accessible environment. Projects may include completed architectural designs, interior designs, landscapes, urban designs or any other built environment. Nominations can be submitted by any individual or group who are interested in accessibility and design. There is no limit to the number of entries which may be submitted. The final date for receipt of nominations is Friday, May 13, 2005.
